

Policy and Procedures – Airedale Terrier Club of Canada (ATCC) Protocol For Boosters

ATCC Boosters may be held in all Regions following application for such being approved by a majority vote at a General Meeting of the ATCC.

A hard copy request for a booster show should be submitted to the Secretary of the ATCC by December of the year preceding the booster show date.

The Regional Director should submit the request for the booster and provide a suggested date and show giving club to the ATCC.

We would prefer that the show giving club offer an obedience trial as well as conformation.

Upon approval from the ATCC, the Regional Director and/or his representative should approach the show giving club for the list of approved judges, and select the day on which to hold the booster.

The Regional Director and/or his representative will act as co-ordinator between the show club and the ATCC and provide the necessary information for the show premium list, catalogues etc.

Immediately following the event closing date, the Regional Director or designate will request the Airedale Terrier entry breakdown for both conformation and obedience from the show secretary and forward same to the Trophy Chair of the ATCC.

The ATCC would provide "keeper" trophies to the co-ordinator (the Regional Director or representative) of the Booster and would expect to receive any and all rebate funds, a premium list, a schedule, and marked catalogue with Airedale Terrier show results for the club's statistics and newsletter.

Financial and other reports to the ATCC are the responsibility of the Regional Director.

All expense receipts for reasonable expenses should be submitted to the treasurer of the ATCC for reimbursement.

It is expected that these events will be financially self supporting.

The number of ATCC booster shows per region will be at the discretion of the executive. The executive will encourage the holding of booster shows in all regions across Canada.
